

Resolution determining that the transfer of a Type 21 Off-Sale General Liquor License from 605 Kearny Street to 612 Kearny Street (District 3) to David C. Huang for David's Food Store will serve the public convenience or necessity of the people of the City and County of San Francisco, in accordance with Section 23958.4 of the California Business and Professions Code, with conditions.

WHEREAS, David C. Huang is seeking the transfer of a Type 21 Off-Sale General Liquor License for David's Food Store, located at 612 Kearny Street; and,

WHEREAS, The City Planning Department has verified that the area is properly zoned; and,

WHEREAS, The Police Department recommends that the liquor license application be approved with conditions; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That in accordance with Section 23958.4 of the California Business and Professions Code, the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby determines for the foregoing reasons that the transfer of a Type 21 Off-Sale General Liquor License from 605 Kearny Street to 612 Kearny Street, for David C. Huang for David's Food Store, will serve the public convenience or necessity of the people of the City and County of San Francisco.

Conditions: 1) The sale and service of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted only between the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. each day of the week except for December 31st from 9 a.m. to January 1st until 2:00 a.m.; 2) No more than 10% of the square footage of the premises will be used for display of alcoholic beverages; 3) No distilled spirits shall be sold in bottles or containers smaller than 375 milliliters; 4) Wine

shall not be sold in bottles or containers smaller than 750 ml. Except for manufacturer pre-packaged multi-unit quantities of four or more; 5) No wine shall be sold with an alcoholic content greater than 15% by volume except "Dinner Wines" which have been aged two years or more and maintained in corked bottles; 6) No malt beverages shall be sold with an alcoholic content greater than 5.7 % by volume; 7) No beer or malt beverages shall be sold in sizes of 12 ounces or smaller in quantities of less than manufacturer pre-packaged six packs per sale with the exception of wine-coolers, beer coolers which must be sold in manufacturer pre-packaged multi-unit quantities of four or more; 8) There shall be no cups, glasses, or similar receptacles commonly used for the drinking of beverages, sold, furnished, or given away at the petitioner's premises in quantities of less than twenty-four in the original multi-container package; 9) All ice shall be sold at or above prevailing prices in the area and in quantities of not less than three pounds per sale and shall not be given away free; 10) No noise shall be audible beyond the area under control of the licensee; 11) No person under the age of 21 shall sell or deliver alcoholic beverages; 12) no alcoholic beverages shall be consumed on any property adjacent to the licensed premises under the control of the licensee; 13) The petitioner shall be responsible for maintaining free of litter the area adjacent to the premises over which they have control; 14) Loitering (loitering is defined as "to stand idly about; linger aimlessly without lawful business") is prohibited on any sidewalks or property adjacent to the licensed premises under the control of the licensee; 15) Graffiti shall be removed from the premises and all parking lots under the control of the licensee within 72 hours of application. If the graffiti occurs on a Friday or weekend day, or on a holiday, the licensee shall remove the graffiti within 72 hours following the beginning of the next weekday; 16) The exterior of the premises shall be equipped with lighting of sufficient power to illuminate and make easily discernible the appearance and

- 16. The exterior of the premises shall be equipped with lighting of sufficient power to illuminate and make easily discernible the appearance and conduct of all persons on or about the premises. Additionally, the position of such lighting shall not disturb the normal privacy and use of any neighboring residences.
