COMMENDING OFFICER BRIAN PEAGLER FOR ENHANCING THE CITY AND COUNTY
OF SAN FRANCISCO'S QUALITY OF LIFE, IN GENERAL, AND THE QUALITY OF LIFE OF
WESTERN ADDITION RESIDENTS, IN PARTICULAR, BY REDUCING THE

WHEREAS, Officer Peagler is a member of the Special Investigations Division, Gang Task Force; and,

WHEREAS, In early 1998, Officer Peagler was assigned to monitor the activities of a street gangs operating out of the Marcus Garvey/Martin Luther King Public Housing Developments and in the vicinity of Fillmore and McAllister Streets; and,

WHEREAS, Those gangs created a state of fear amongst the residents of such developments and amongst citizens passing through those areas as gang controlled drug trafficing led to an escalation of violent incidents and a broad array of related criminal activity; and,

WHEREAS, In October 1998, Officer Peagler coordinated a joint investigation of such gang activity that resulted in the largest single warrant service operation ever attempted by the San Francisco Police Department followed by another warrant service operation in December of that year; and,

WHEREAS, Such warrant service operations not only resulted in a significant number of arrests but also yielded numerous firearms/ammunition, large quantities of narcotics, U.S.

currency, stolen property and evidence substantiating the existence of the aforementioned organized criminal street gangs; and,

WHEREAS, As a result of Officer's Peagler's relentless efforts, superb investigative, command and coordinating skills, and absolute dedication to protect and serve the citizens of the City and County of San Francisco, the street gangs in question experienced major set backs; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors extends its highest commendation to Officer Peagler for epitomizing the very best the City and County of San Francisco expects from its police officers and for enhancing the City's quality of life in general, and the quality of life Western Addition residents, in particular, by reducing the effectiveness of criminal gang related activities in that community; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby names Monday, April 19th, Officer Peagler day in the City and County of San Francisco.
