WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco, by and through its Department of Disability and Aging Services, wishes to provide grant funding for services provided to the community for the Food Assistance Program; and

WHEREAS, On November 4, 2024, the Department of Disability and Aging Services issued a Request for Proposals ("RFP") #1176 for the Food Assistance Program; and

WHEREAS, San Francisco-Marin Food Bank submitted a proposal and was the highest ranked proposer; and

WHEREAS, The Department of Disability and Aging Services awarded the agreement to San Francisco-Marin Food Bank in the total amount not to exceed \$12,604,048 for the period from July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2029; and

WHEREAS, On March 5, 2025, the Department of Disability and Aging Services

Commission approved the proposed Food Assistance Program grant with San Francisco-

Marin Food Bank (the "Grant Agreement") in a total amount not to exceed \$12,604,048 for the period from July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2029; and

WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco, by and through its Department of Disability and Aging Services, now wishes to enter into the Grant Agreement with San Francisco-Marin Food Bank; and

WHEREAS, Charter, Section 9.118(b), requires Board of Supervisors' approval by Resolution of any contract which, when entered into, extends over 10 years, and of any contract which, when entered into, costs the City \$10,000,000 or more; and

WHEREAS, The proposed Grant Agreement contained in File No. 250379, is substantially in final form, with all material terms and conditions included, and only remains to be executed by the parties upon approval of this Resolution; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby approves the Grant Agreement in substantially the form contained in File No. 250379; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Department of Disability and Aging Services to make any modifications to the Grant Agreement prior to its final execution by all parties, that Department of Disability and Aging Services determines, in consultation with the City Attorney, are consistent with this Resolution, in the best interest of the City, do not materially increase the obligations or liabilities of the City, are necessary or advisable to effectuate the purposes of the Grant Agreement, and are in compliance with all applicable laws, including City's Charter; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That within 30 days of the Grant Agreement being fully executed by all parties, the Department of Disability and Aging Services shall submit to the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors a completely executed copy for inclusion in
