honor Leslie Trutner, who is moving on from her nine years of exemplary public service as a
Deputy City Attorney specializing in the development and financing of affordable housing; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Trutner has devoted her considerable legal talents to advising and
representing the offices and officials of the City and County of San Francisco, including the
Board of Supervisors, the Mayor's Office of Housing, the Mayor's Office of Community
Development, the Mayor's Office of Economic Development, and the Real Estate Department,
as well as the Housing Authority and the Redevelopment Agency; and

WHEREAS, The City and its residents have benefited from Ms. Trutner's leadership on
numerous affordable housing, community development, and real estate projects, including the
Mission Bay housing program, the Proposition A affordable housing bond program, the

homeowner rehabilitation programs, the disadvantaged minority business contractor bonding
assistance program, and at least 233 individual housing developments producing over 6,600
units for San Francisco's low income residents; and

WHEREAS, As the City's top legal expert on affordable housing, Ms. Trutner played a
key role in the development of the City's policies and programs for affordable housing, and has
provided legal guidance on a wide range of matters, including the development of legal opinions
of the City Attorney on a number of significant legal issues; and
