

1 [Gift – Streetlights and Poles]

2 [ACCEPTING STREETLIGHTS AND POLES AS A GIFT TO LIGHT 21ST STREET BETWEEN
3 NOE AND SANCHEZ STREETS]

4 WHEREAS, A group of residents of 21st Street between Noe and Sanchez Streets
5 desire to give to the City and County of San Francisco five (5) post-top streetlight fixtures and
6 poles estimated at an \$11,210 value to light the designated area identical to the post-top
7 streetlights recently installed and accepted by the City on the adjacent streets in Dolores
8 Heights; and,

9 WHEREAS, The residents of 21st Street between Noe and Sanchez Streets would pay
10 for all costs associated with the purchase of the five (5) post-top streetlight fixtures and poles;
11 and

12 WHEREAS, These streetlights would meet the Requirements of all applicable City and
13 State standards; and

14 WHEREAS, pursuant to Administrative Code Section 10.116 it is necessary for the
15 Board of Supervisors to accept this gift of streetlights because their value exceeds \$5,000;
16 now, therefore be it

17 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors does accept on behalf of the City and
18 County of San Francisco the aforementioned street lighting, provided that it is acceptable to
19 the Hetch Hetchy Water and Power Department and Bureau of Light, Heat and Power.


