9	WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco has negotiated with the Federal
10	General Services Administration (GSA) for the transfer to the City of the Old Mint at Fifth and
11	Mission Streets; and
	WHEREAS, The City has reached agreement with the GSA on the terms of said
12	transfer; and,
13	WHEREAS, The City is willing to accept title to the Old Mint, provided a fitting public
14	use for the building is determined and a realistic funding program for the rehabilitation,
15	maintenance and operation of the Old Mint is identified; and,
16	WHEREAS, In mid-June the Mayor's Office of Economic Development issued a
17	Request for Proposals for the lease of the Old Mint; and,
18	WHEREAS, The San Francisco Museum and Historical Society, the City's officially
19	designated history museum, responded to the Request for Proposals; and,
20	WHEREAS, The City is now reviewing the Society's response and anticipates entering
21	into negotiations with the Society for an exclusive development agreement; and,
22	WHEREAS, The City's Congressional and State Legislative delegations have
23	expressed support for both the proposed re-use of the Old Mint as a public museum and a

1	public-private partnership to fund the restoration project, as evidenced by letters of support
2	submitted with the Society's response; and,
3	WHEREAS, in March 2002, the people of California approved Proposition 40 to
4	provide monies for parks, open space and public facilities, including over \$250,000,000 for
5	museums and cultural resources; and,
6	WHEREAS, The Federal government, as the owner of the Old Mint for almost 130
7	years should participate with the State and City in the seismic upgrade and restoration costs;
8	now, therefore, be it
9	RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco respectfully urges the
10	Congress of the United States to appropriate \$10 million over the next three years towards
11	the seismic and life safety improvements required to the Old Mint before it can be occupied;
12	and, be it
13	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco respectfully urges
14	the California State Legislature to appropriate a like amount of \$10 million dollars from
15	Proposition 40 funds to further the restoration of the historically significant Old Mint; and, be it
16	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Mayor is requested to take all steps necessary to
17	inform our Congressional and State Legislative delegations of the priority given this request
18	and to encourage favorable legislative action.
