WHEREAS, In November 1997 in an attempt to settle the litigation, the voters of San Francisco overwhelmingly approved Proposition F which authorized the City to sell the land on Mt. Davidson on which the cross is located to the highest bidder; and,

WHEREAS, The Council of Armenian American Organizations of Northern California was the successful bidder and has preserved the cross on Mount Davidson as a memorial to the Armenian Genocide; and,

WHEREAS, Subsequent to this voter approval and successful sale, litigation continued until April 28, 2003 when the Supreme Court of the United States refused to hear the case, which, in effect, ends the litigation and finalizes the legal issues surrounding the cross on Mount Davidson; and,

WHEREAS, The City Attorney's Office, including seven current and former Deputy City Attorneys, Teresa Stricker, Ellen Forman, Kate Stacy, Mariam Morley, Mara Rosales, Peter Obstler and Elizabeth Dietrich worked countless hours and put in a great deal of effort on this case; and,

WHEREAS, In addition to the work of the City Attorney's Office under both City

Attorney Louise Renne and City Attorney Dennis Herrera, the cross on Mount Davidson

would not have been saved without the assistance and leadership of the Council of Armenian

American Organizations of Northern California; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco commends the City Attorney's Office, including Deputy City Attorneys Teresa Stricker, Ellen Forman, Kate Stacy and Mariam Morley, Former Deputy City Attorneys Mara Rosales, Peter Obstler and Elizabeth Dietrich for their successful efforts in court to defend the sale of the cross and settle the litigation; and, be it
