8 WHEREAS, 19th Avenue grows more congested each day with thousands of cars
9 flowing into the City of San Francisco; and

10 WHEREAS, Many residents are concerned about the appearance and condition of 19th
11 Avenue; and

12 WHEREAS, Planting trees, bushes and greenery is a proven method of traffic calming;
13 and

14 WHEREAS, Greenery has the ability to remove airborne pollutants from the thousands
15 of cars that travel along the 19th Avenue thoroughfare each day; and

16 WHEREAS, Trees and shrubbery will serve as a means of noise reduction and visual
17 enhancement for 19th Avenue; and

18 WHEREAS, The improvement of Sunset Boulevard by planting trees and plants has
19 greatly enhanced the community; and

20 WHEREAS, The City of San Francisco has the duty to provide environmentally
21 sensitive surroundings for the residents; now, therefore, be it,

22 **RESOLVED**, That the Board of Supervisors urges the Department of Public Works to
23 perform a feasibility study of landscaping the 19th Avenue median.
