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3 **Resolution determining that the transfer of a Type-21 off-sale general beer, wine,**
4 **and distilled spirits liquor license to Golden State Food & Liquor, Inc., located**
5 **at 1859 Market Street (District 8), will serve the public convenience or necessity of**
6 **the City and County of San Francisco; and requesting that the California**
7 **Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control impose conditions on the issuance of**
8 **the license.**

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10 WHEREAS, Golden State Food & Liquor, Inc., is seeking the transfer of a
11 Type-21 off-sale general beer, wine, and distilled spirits liquor license to do business as
12 Golden State Food & Liquor, located at 1859 Market Street (District 8); and

13 WHEREAS, The Planning Department has verified that the area is properly
14 zoned and recommends approval; and

15 WHEREAS, The Police Department has filed one protests and zero letters of
16 support with the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control under California Business
17 and Professions Code, Section 24013, and recommends that the Department of
18 Alcoholic Beverage Control issue the liquor license with conditions; and

19 WHEREAS, The conditions recommended by the Police Department are the
20 following: 1) Sales, service and consumption of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted
21 only between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 1:00 a.m. each day of the week; 2) The sale of
22 distilled spirits in sizes smaller than 200 milliliters is strictly prohibited; 3) Beer, malt
23 beverages, and wine coolers in containers of 16 ounces or less cannot be sold by single
24 containers, but must be sold in manufacturer pre-packaged multi-unit quantities; and 4)
25 Petitioner(s) shall actively monitor the area under their control in an effort to prevent the

1 loitering of persons on any property adjacent to the licensed premises as depicted on
2 ABC-253; now, therefore, be it

3 RESOLVED, That in accordance with California Business and Professions Code,
4 Section 23958.4, the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
5 hereby determines that the transfer of a Type 21 off-sale general beer, wine, and
6 distilled spirits liquor license to Golden State Food & Liquor, Inc., located at 1859
7 Market Street (District 8), will serve the public convenience or necessity of the City and
8 County of San Francisco; and, be it

9 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of
10 San Francisco hereby endorses and adopts the recommendations of the Police
11 Department listed above and recommends that the Department of Alcoholic Beverage
12 Control issue the license with those conditions.
