As we have all discussed, we were unable to complete the SF Marine 10 repower grant project as BAAQMD determined the project to not meet its requirements for smog reduction. As such, we have notified the State's Parks and Rec, Division of Boating Waterways that their partial funding for this project (\$77,000) will not be needed and that we wish to reallocate those funds to other critical projects that we have here at the Marine Unit.

On Friday the State provided me with the attached updated grant award agreement, notating the exact projects and amounts for which we intend to expend the \$77,000.
