

1 Expand mental health services to transgender racial and ethnic minorities in non-mental  
2 health settings.]

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4 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (SFDPH) to**  
5 **accept and expend retroactively a grant in the amount of \$400,000 for the first year of**  
6 **three years from the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration**  
7 **(SAMHSA) to expand mental health services for racial and ethnic minority transgenders**  
8 **in non-mental health settings and to enter into an agreement for the use of these funds;**  
9 **for the period of October 1, 2001 to September 30, 2002.**

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11 WHEREAS, SFDPH has applied for and been awarded a grant in the amount of  
12 \$400,000 for the first year of three years from SAMHSA to expand mental health services for  
13 racial and ethnic minority transgenders in non-mental health settings; and,

14 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, SAMHSA requires the City to  
15 enter into an agreement (the "Agreement"), a notice of which is on file with the Clerk of the  
16 Board of Supervisors in File No. \_\_\_\_\_, which is hereby declared to be a part of this  
17 resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

18 WHEREAS, The grant budget includes provision for indirect costs of \$9,331; now,  
19 therefore, be it

20 RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend retroactively a  
21 grant in the amount of \$400,000 from SAMHSA; and, be it

22 FURTHER RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend the  
23 grant funds in accordance with the requirements set forth in the Agreement pursuant to the  
24 San Francisco Administrative Code section 10-170-1; and, be it

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1            FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the  
2 Agreement in behalf of the City; and, be it

3            FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate the positions  
4 created under the grant as a “G” or grant-funded positions, which would terminate when the  
5 grant expires.
