Louisa Mendoza, seat 1, succeeding themself, term expired, must have a minimum of five years professional experience in the State of California as one of the following: certified public accountant or public accountant; licensed real estate broker; attorney; or a property appraiser accredited by a nationally recognized professional organization, certified by the Office of Real Estate Appraisers, or certified by the State Board of Equalization, for the unexpired portion of a three-year term ending September 6, 2027;

Nicholas Goldman, seat 5, succeeding Stephen Wasserman, term expired, must have a minimum of five years professional experience in the State of California as one of the following: certified public accountant or public accountant; licensed real estate broker; attorney; or a property appraiser accredited by a nationally recognized professional organization, certified by the Office of Real Estate Appraisers, or certified by the State Board of Equalization, for the unexpired portion of a three-year term ending September 6, 2027;

Michelle Domingo (residency requirement waived), vacant seat 6, (ALTERNATE MEMBER) must have a minimum of five years professional experience in the State of California as one of the following: certified public accountant or public accountant; licensed real estate broker; attorney; or a property appraiser accredited by a nationally recognized professional organization, certified by the Office of Real Estate Appraisers, or certified by the State Board of Equalization, for the unexpired portion of a three-year term ending September 6, 2027;

Joyce Lewis, vacant seat 7, (ALTERNATE MEMBER) must have a minimum of five years professional experience in the State of California as one of the following: certified public accountant or public accountant; licensed real estate broker; attorney; or a property appraiser accredited by a nationally recognized professional organization, certified by the Office of Real Estate Appraisers, or certified by the State Board of Equalization, for the unexpired portion of a three-year term ending September 6, 2027;

Claire Ervin Lee (residency requirement waived), vacant seat 8, (ALTERNATE MEMBER) must have a minimum of five years professional experience in the State of California as one of the following: certified public accountant or public accountant; licensed real estate broker; attorney; or a property appraiser accredited by a nationally recognized professional organization, certified by the Office of Real Estate Appraisers, or certified by the State Board of Equalization, for the unexpired portion of a three-year term ending September 6, 2027 September 7, 2026; and, be it

FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors makes the following findings:

1. The membership of the Assessment Appeals Board No. 2 has a goal to be representative of the diversity of the City and County of San Francisco.

- 2. Applicants Michelle Domingo and Claire Ervin Lee, who are not residents of San Francisco, are persons with experience that uniquely qualifies them to serve on the Assessment Appeals Board No. 2.
- 3. The Assessment Appeals Board No. 2 has attempted to fill these positions, for which Michelle Domingo and Claire Ervin Lee were nominated, with individuals who are City residents and who have the specific experience, skills, and qualifications, but have been unable to do so at this time. The Rules Committee has certified that Michelle Domingo and Claire Ervin Lee are qualified to serve on the Assessment Appeals Board No. 2.
- 4. After exercising due diligence, the Board of Supervisors concludes that there is no other possible representatives who are residents of San Francisco, who have the specific experience, skills, or qualifications possessed by these applicants, and who are willing to serve on the Assessment Appeals Board No. 2 at this time; and, be it FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives the residency requirement for Michelle Domingo and Claire Ervin Lee, as is allowed in cases where no qualified City resident who is willing to serve can be found, pursuant to Charter, Section 4.101(b), that otherwise requires person(s) appointed to boards, commissions, and advisory bodies established by legislative act of the Board of Supervisors to be resident(s) of the City and
