3 **Resolution urging the San Francisco City Attorney to file a 'friend of the court'/amicus**
4 **curiae' brief to set forth our city's interest in protecting tenants against wrongful**
5 **evictions.**

7 WHEREAS, San Francisco's Rent Stabilization and Arbitration Ordinance provides for
8 protections against evictions without good cause and requires notices to tenants to accurately
9 state reasons for the termination; and,

10 WHEREAS, A Court of Appeals opinion in litigation entitled Action Apartment
11 Association v. City of Santa Monica (Court of Appeal No. B16581) invalidated a portion of the
12 City of Santa Monica's rent ordinance which provided for relief against wrongful eviction; and,

13 WHEREAS, The California Supreme Court has granted the City of Santa Monica's
14 petition for review of the opinion in Action Apartment Association and is presently considering
15 arguments presented by the parties and the public; and,

16 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco has an interest in preserving its
17 authority to provide protections to its residents against wrongful evictions as set forth in the
18 city's Rent Stabilization and Arbitration Ordinance; and,

19 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco may request the court to consider a
20 friend of the court brief to set forth its interest in providing protections and remedies for its
21 residents against wrongful evictions; now, therefore, be it

22 RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco should seek leave of court to
23 file a 'friend of the court'/amicus curiae brief to set forth our city's interest in protecting tenants
24 against wrongful evictions; and, be it
