4 **a Type-48 on- general public premises beer, wine, and distilled spirits liquor**  
5 **license to 77 ASSETS LLC, doing business as Bark 77, located at 77 Cambon**  
6 **Drive (District 7), will serve the public convenience or necessity of the City and**  
7 **County of San Francisco, in accordance with California Business and**  
8 **Professions Code, Section 23958.4; and requesting that the California Department**  
9 **of Alcoholic Beverage Control impose conditions on the issuance of the license.**

11 WHEREAS, 77 ASSETS LLC, is seeking the person-to-person, premise-to-  
12 premise transfer of a Type-48 on-sale general public premises beer, wine, and distilled  
13 spirits liquor license to do business as Bark 77, located at 77 Cambon Drive; and

14 WHEREAS, The Planning Department has verified that the area is properly  
15 zoned and recommends approval; and

16 WHEREAS, The Police Department has filed one protest and zero letters of  
17 support with the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control under California Business  
18 and Professions Code, Section 24013, and recommends that the Department of  
19 Alcoholic Beverage Control issue the liquor license with conditions; and

20 WHEREAS, The conditions recommended by the Police Department are the  
21 following: 1) (1) Except as provided in Condition 2 below, no noise shall be audible  
22 beyond the area under the control of the licensee; 2) (2) Any noise caused by  
23 entertainment or amplified sound that is subject to the provisions of an active  
24 Entertainment Permit issued by the San Francisco Entertainment Commission shall be  
25 authorized in accordance with the limits established by that Entertainment Permit,

1 including any limitation on hours during which entertainment or amplified sound is  
2 permitted. A violation of the entertainment or amplified sound noise conditions of the  
3 Entertainment Permit, as determined by the San Francisco Entertainment Commission  
4 (or any successor agency), shall be deemed to be a violation of this Condition. Any  
5 noise that is not subject to, or is beyond the scope of, the Entertainment Permit shall be  
6 subject to Condition I above. "Entertainment Permit" means any of the following: a Just  
7 Add Music permit, a Limited Live Performance permit, a Place of Entertainment permit,  
8 a Fixed Place Amplified Sound permit, or any similar such permit issued by the San  
9 Francisco Entertainment Commission; 3) Petitioner(s) shall actively monitor the area  
10 under their control in an effort to prevent the loitering of persons on any property  
11 adjacent to the licensed premises as depicted on the ABC-257; 4) The petitioner(s)  
12 shall be responsible for maintaining free of litter the area adjacent to the premises over  
13 which they have control, as depicted on ABC-257; now, therefore, be it

14         RESOLVED, That in accordance with California Business and Professions Code,  
15 Section 23958.4, the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco  
16 hereby determines that the person-to-person, premise-to-premise transfer of a Type-48

Our bar will enhance the quality of life in the Park Merced neighborhood by offering a comfortable, well-managed place for residents to socialize and enjoy community events. Our establishment will provide a welcoming atmosphere and a safe space for neighbors to gather, whether to watch a game or celebrate local occasions.

Sound control has been one of our highest priorities. The building has installed sound-proof windows and doors, and we maintain all interior music and TV audio at normal levels. We are not a nightclub and do not host loud entertainment. Doors will remain closed during any busy periods, and our staff will actively monitor the entrance area to ensure guests behave respectfully and do not disturb nearby residents.

We aim to become a true community hub. In addition to everyday sports viewing, we plan to host small celebrations, birthday gatherings, local events, and themed nights that bring neighbors together. Our space is designed to welcome longtime residents and students, offering a friendly atmosphere. We want residents to feel comfortable stopping by to meet friends or enjoy community-oriented activities.

Safety is a top priority. We have installed a comprehensive security system with more than 20 cameras covering both indoor and outdoor areas. We are also implementing a professional ID-scanning system to verify the authenticity of every ID and maintain a secure record if any issue arises. Our staff will be trained in responsible alcohol service, and during peak hours or special events we will have security personnel on site. Our goal is to maintain a safe, controlled, and respectful environment for everyone in the community.

The bar will generate new local jobs, support neighboring businesses through increased foot traffic, and contribute additional tax revenue to the city. We will be hiring bartenders, security, and support positions, and we aim to work with local vendors whenever possible. Revitalizing this commercial space also brings long-term economic stability to the Park Merced neighborhood.

Our establishment offers a balanced experience not currently available in the neighborhood: a bar that combines relaxed socializing and community-focused activities. Our emphasis on safety, responsible operations, and neighborhood engagement makes us distinct from typical nightclub-type concepts and fills an important gap in the local social landscape.

We are fully willing to accept reasonable conditions that address community or law-enforcement concerns. Our goal is to be a responsible, safe, and positive addition to the neighborhood, and we welcome collaboration to ensure we meet that standard. Thank you for your time and consideration.

Hi Monique, I live in Park Merced and I am member of Park Merced Tenants association and live beside this proposed bar and I and a number of residents have grave reservations about this proposal. The previous tenant gave no consideration to the quality of life of residents who live nearby. On weekends it was impossible to get to sleep until well after 3am and during the week they had karaoke night which also ran late. Police were called on a number of occasions to the parking lot because of fights and people were also gathering in the parking lot and drinking.

I spoke on a number of occasions with the bar staff regarding the noise and their response was "once they are out of the bar it has nothing to do with me". I would like to know what the new tenants' plans are regarding providing security inside and outside the bar, especially after closing time. I would to know when the hearing is taking place and if the public can attend as and other residents would to be heard.

The Police Department's ALU is recommending approval with the following conditions:

1. Petitioner(s) shall actively monitor the area under their control in an effort to prevent the loitering of persons on any property adjacent to the licensed premises as depicted on ABC-257.
2. The petitioner(s) shall be responsible for maintaining free of litter the area adjacent to the premises over which they have control, as depicted on ABC-257.
3. When the said outdoor patio area of the premises is being utilized for the sales, service and consumption of alcoholic beverages, a premise employee shall be in attendance and maintain continuous supervision at all times of said area to ensure orderly conduct of patrons.
4. The parking lot of the premises shall be equipped with lighting of sufficient power to illuminate and make easily discernible the appearance and conduct of persons on or about the parking lot. Additionally, the position of such lighting shall not disturb the normal privacy and use of any neighboring residences.

**The Public Safety and Neighborhood Services Committee will hold this hearing at a meeting in April 2026.**

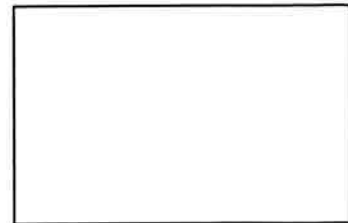
