10	WHEREAS, The SFDPH has applied for and been awarded a grant from the CSAT in		
11	the amount of \$492,317 for the second year of a medication adherence support program that		
12	assists HIV infected urban poor to adhere to antiretroviral medications; and,		
13	WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, CSAT requires the City to		
14	enter into an agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the		
15	Board of Supervisors in File No, which is hereby declared to be a part		
16	of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,		
17	WHEREAS, The grant budget includes provision for indirect costs of \$12,008; now,		
18	therefore, be it		
19	RESOLVED, That the SFDPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend retroactively		
20	a grant in the amount of \$492,317 from CSAT; and, be it		
21	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the SFDPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend		
22	the grant funds in accordance with the requirements set forth in the Agreement pursuant to		
23	San Francisco Administrative Code section 10-170-1; and, be it		
24	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the		
25	Agreement in behalf of the City; and, be it		

1	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate the positions		
2	created under the grant as "G" or grant-funded positions, which would terminate when the		
3	grant expires.
