WHEREAS, By Act of Congress of the United States dated December 6, 1865, the 13<sup>th</sup> Amendment of the Constitution of the United States was adopted abolishing slavery; and,

WHEREAS, By Act of Congress the United States dated July 9, 1868, the 14<sup>th</sup> Amendment of the Constitution of the United States was adopted giving all persons born or naturalized in the United States the right to due process and equal protection under the law; and,

WHEREAS, By resolution of the City and County of San Francisco, we declare racism unjust and advocate equal rights for all; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco proclaims September 20, 2000 as "Undoing Racism Day" in San Francisco and urge all citizens to join together for the first annual "Undoing Racism Day" to reaffirm our commitment to ensure equality and freedom for all people regardless of race, religion, sexual orientation, or gender; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco become a signatory to this resolution as it was advanced by the National League of Cities; and, be it
