Resolution in support of Proposition 89, the California Clean Money and Fair Elections Act of 2006 on November 7, 2006.

WHEREAS, San Francisco Board of Supervisors has a strong interest in elections that are accountable to the voters; and

WHEREAS, The needs of municipalities, along with those of individual citizens and the nonprofit sector, are all too often pushed aside due to the influence of well financed special interests in Sacramento; and

WHEREAS, The influence of special interests divert resources from municipalities, education, healthcare, and other human needs; and

WHEREAS, Positive change in our city, in the economy, education, healthcare, human and civil rights, social justice, and the environment depends upon a fair elections system; and

WHEREAS, So many of our finest public servants and office holders must spend too many hours raising the money necessary to run election campaigns - hours that, otherwise, could be spent listening to leaders from our municipalities, the economy, non-profit sectors and to the people; and

WHEREAS, Arizona, Maine, and Connecticut have passed propositions and laws to limit campaign contributions; which increase turnout instead of cynicism; and which promote pride instead of derision; and

WHEREAS, Proposition 89, the California Clean Money and Fair Elections Act of 2006, is modeled on Maine's, Arizona's and Connecticut's propositions and laws, providing for voluntary public financing for California statewide and legislative races, as well as contribution limits for campaigns and ballot measure; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco supports Proposition 89, the California Clean Money and Fair Elections Act of 2006 on November 7th, 2006.
