[Liquor License, 585 Columbus Avenue]

Resolution determining that the issuance of a Type 42 on-sale beer and wine public premises license to Jeffrey Branco for Paired Wines & Spirits dba as Coit Liquor located at 585 Columbus Avenue, will serve the public convenience and necessity of the people of the City and County of San Francisco, in accordance with Section 23958.4 of the California Business and Professions Code with conditions.

WHEREAS, Jeffrey Branco is seeking issuance of a type 42 on-sale beer and wine public premises license for Paired Wines & Spirits dba as Coit Liquor, located at 585 Columbus Avenue; and,

WHEREAS, The City Planning Department has verified that the area is properly zoned; and

WHEREAS, The Police Department recommends that the liquor license application be approved with conditions; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That in accordance with Section 23958.4 of the California Business and Professions Code, the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby determines for the foregoing reasons that the issuance of a type 42 on-sale beer and wine public premises license, to Jeffrey Branco for Paired Wines & Spirits dba as Coit Liquor, located at 585 Columbus Avenue will serve the public convenience and necessity of the people of the City and County of San Francisco.

Conditions: (1) No noise shall be audible beyond the area under control of the licensee; (2) Petitioners shall no permit their patrons or the general public to loiter or congregate on the sidewalks adjacent to the licensed premises; (3) The petitioner(s)

shall be responsible for maintaining free of litter the area adjacent to the premises over which they have control; (4) Beer and wine tasting shall be limited to the hours between 10:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m.; (5) Individual servings shall not exceed four-ounce pours of beer and wine; (6) The tasking area shall not exceed an area of 135 square feet and shall not include chairs, seats, or stools. Exceptions may be made for disabled customers.; (7) No person under the age of 21 years shall be allowed in the tasting area which shall be physically separated from the liquor store with an appropriate barrier; (8) The beer and wine tasting license (Type 42) shall be held in conjunction with the stores off-sale license (Type 21).
