

LEGISLATIVE DIGEST

[Administrative Code - Transferring Data Collection Oversight Duties from the City Administrator to the Human Rights Commission]

Ordinance amending the Administrative Code to transfer responsibilities for oversight of the collection of sexual orientation and gender identity data from the City Administrator to the Human Rights Commission and removing obsolete reporting requirements.

Existing Law

Chapter 104 of the Administrative Code requires the City Administrator to oversee departments' collection of sexual orientation and gender identity data. Departments are currently required to report their compliance to the City Administrator on an annual basis.

Amendments to Current Law

This ordinance would amend Chapter 104 of the Administrative Code to replace the City Administrator with the Human Rights Commission ("HRC"). Departments' obligations to collect data and report their compliance would remain the same, except that departments would direct their reports to HRC rather than the City Administrator. The ordinance would also remove reference to a one-time reporting requirement from 2017. That requirement is now obsolete.
