3 **Motion concurring in the continuation of the “Rim Fire” Revised Declaration of Local**
4 **Emergency by the Mayor and in the actions taken to meet the emergency.**

6 WHEREAS, On August 22, 2013, Acting Mayor Mark E. Farrell issued a Declaration of
7 Local Emergency under Charter, Section 3.100(14), and California Government Code,
8 Section 8630, in connection with the wildfire that began on August 17, 2013, in the Stanislaus
9 National Forest Area (the “Rim Fire”); and

10 WHEREAS, On September 3, 2013, under the same statutory authorities, the Board of
11 Supervisors concurred in the Declaration of Local Emergency in Motion No. M13-109, on file
12 with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 130809, which is hereby declared to be
13 a part of this Motion as if set forth fully herein; and

14 WHEREAS, On September 19, 2013, Mayor Edwin M. Lee issued a Revised
15 Declaration of Local Emergency for the Rim Fire; and

16 WHEREAS, On September 24, 2013, the Board of Supervisors concurred in the
17 Revised Declaration of Local Emergency in Motion No. M13-116, on file with the Clerk of the
18 Board of Supervisors in File No. 130900, which is hereby declared to be a part of this Motion
19 as if set forth fully herein; and

20 WHEREAS, On October 22, 2013, the Board of Supervisors concurred in the
21 continuation of the Revised Declaration of Local Emergency in Motion No. M13-136, on file
22 with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 131015, which is hereby declared to be
23 a part of this Motion as if set forth fully herein; and

24 WHEREAS, On November 19, 2013, the Board of Supervisors concurred in the
25 continuation of the Revised Declaration of Local Emergency in Motion No. M13-151, on file

7 WHEREAS, On January 14, 2014, the Board of Supervisors concurred in the
8 continuation of the Revised Declaration of Local Emergency in Motion No. M14-005, on file
9 with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 140003, which is hereby declared to be
10 a part of this Motion as if set forth fully herein; and

11 WHEREAS, On February 11, 2014, the Board of Supervisors concurred in the
12 continuation of the Revised Declaration of Local Emergency in Motion No. M14-016, on file
13 with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 140110, which is hereby declared to be
14 a part of this Motion as if set forth fully herein; and

15 WHEREAS, On March 11, 2014, the Board of Supervisors concurred in the
16 continuation of the Revised Declaration of Local Emergency in Motion No. M14-032, on file
17 with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 140201, which is hereby declared to be
18 a part of this Motion as if set forth fully herein; and

19 WHEREAS, On April 8, 2014, the Board of Supervisors concurred in the continuation of
20 the Revised Declaration of Local Emergency in Motion No. M14-052, on file with the Clerk of
21 the Board of Supervisors in File No. 140325, which is hereby declared to be a part of this
22 Motion as if set forth fully herein; and

23 WHEREAS, Government Code, Section 8630, provides that, when a local emergency
24 has been declared, "[t]he governing body shall review the need for continuing the local

1 emergency at least once every 30 days until the governing body terminates the local
2 emergency;" and

3 WHEREAS, Conditions threatening the lives, property or welfare of the City and County
4 of San Francisco or its citizens continue to exist in the connection with the Rim Fire, including
5 damage to property and equipment of San Francisco Public Utilities Commission and
6 Recreation and Park Department resources; and

7 WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors does hereby find that the aforesaid conditions of
8 extreme peril justify and require the continuation of the declaration of local emergency; and

9 WHEREAS, The Mayor's Office has submitted a memorandum to the Board of
10 Supervisors, on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 140440, confirming
11 the emergency conditions and concluding that it is in the best interest of the City to continue
12 the local emergency; now, therefore, be it

13 MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors concurs in the continuation of the Revised
14 Declaration of Local Emergency issued by the Mayor, and in the actions taken by the Mayor
15 to meet the emergency; and, be it

16 FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby directs the Clerk of the
17 Board to agendize a successive motion concurring in the continuation of the Rim Fire Revised
18 Declaration of Local Emergency to be heard no later than 30 days from the date of passage of
19 this Motion.

The Department of Emergency Management and the Public Utilities Commission (PUC) have requested that our office seek a monthly recurring item on the Board of Supervisors agenda to continue the Local Emergency related to the Rim Fire through Spring of 2014. In order to protect the Hetch Hetchy Water and Power System, the PUC continues to seek flexibility to rapidly hire contactors to repair ongoing damage to roads, power poles, and other City assets resulting from rain, snow, and associated runoff in the burn area.

Under state law, the Local Emergency must be renewed every 30 days by the Board of Supervisors or else it expires. As you know, the Board last extended the emergency on January 14, 2013. We respectfully request that this item again be calendared for Adoption Without Committee Reference on the following dates:

- February 11
- March 11
- April 8
- May 6
- June 3
