COMMENDING OFFICERS COTA AND O'MAHONEY FOR THEIR BRAVERY IN THWARTING THE ARMED ROBBERY IN SAN FRANCISCO ON JANUARY 15, 1999.

WHEREAS, Shortly after 5:00 p.m. on Friday, January 15, 1999, an armed robber entered the Bank of America branch at New Montgomery and Market Streets in downtown San Francisco: and,

WHEREAS, The robber shot a "Good Samaritan," later identified as Antonio Castillo, two times in the face while the Samaritan attempted to prevent injury to bank employees and to bank customers; and,

WHEREAS, The robber terrified bank customers and bank employees before escaping via Market and Second Streets toward Mission Street with a bag full of stolen money; and,

WHEREAS, A silent alarm in the bank alerted San Francisco Police Officers, including Officer Mark Cota and Officer Dennis O'Mahoney of the Police Department's Tenderloin Task Force, of the crime, causing the police to immediately respond and purse the criminal; and,

WHEREAS, The robber further placed other innocent citizens at peril by initiating a gun battle between himself and San Francisco Police Officers, including Officers Cota and O'Mahoney, who were in pursuit of the robber; and,

WHEREAS, Officers Cota and O'Mahoney sustained severe gunshot injuries during the gun battle; and,

WHEREAS, Officers Cota and O'Mahoney defended the citizens of San Francisco with exceptional bravery and skill; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco commends Officers O'Mahoney and Cota for their bravery in thwarting the armed robbery in San Francisco on January 15, 1999.
