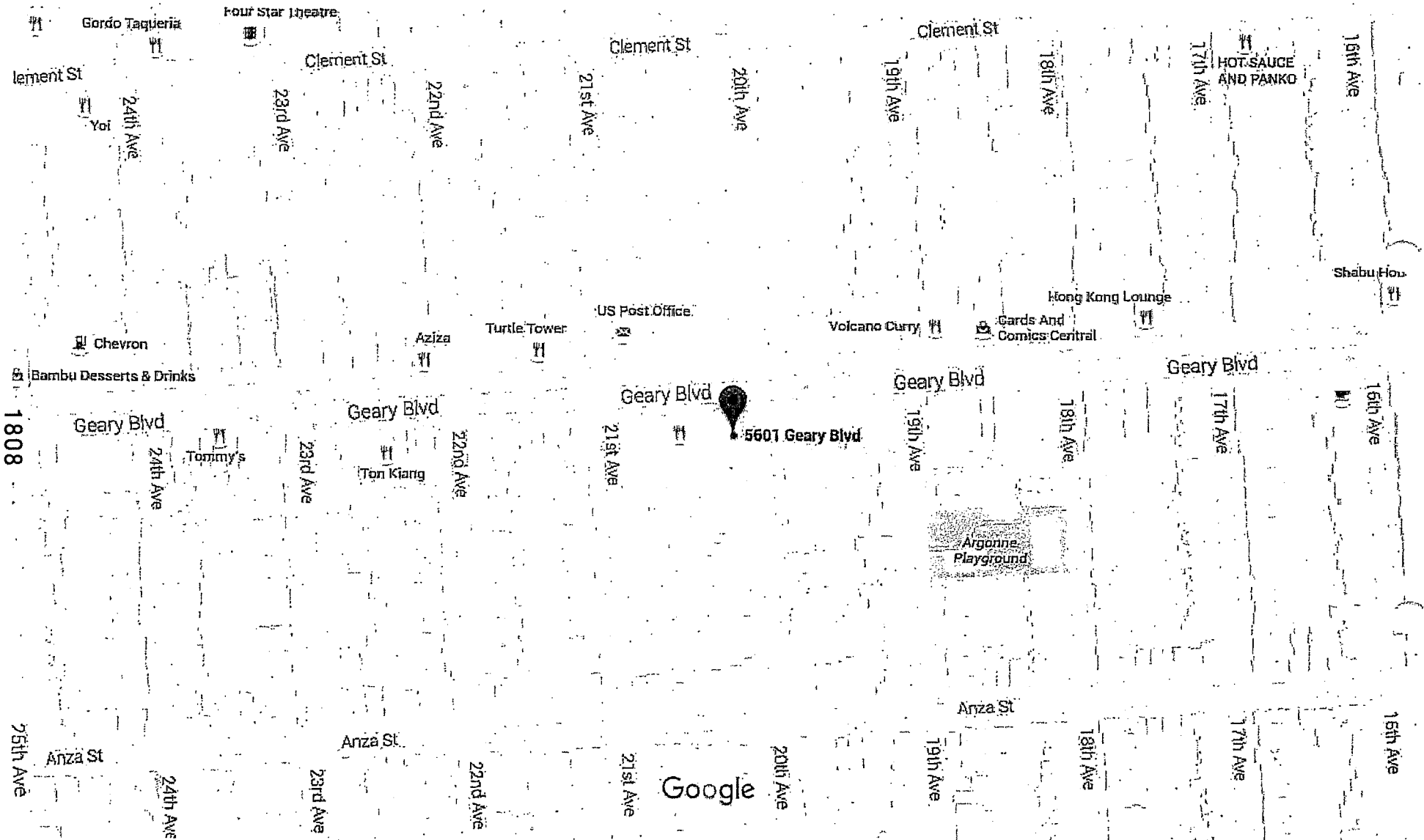

  4. Loitering (loitering is defined as "to stand idly about; linger aimlessly without lawful business") is prohibited on any sidewalks or property adjacent to the licensed premises under the control of the licensee.

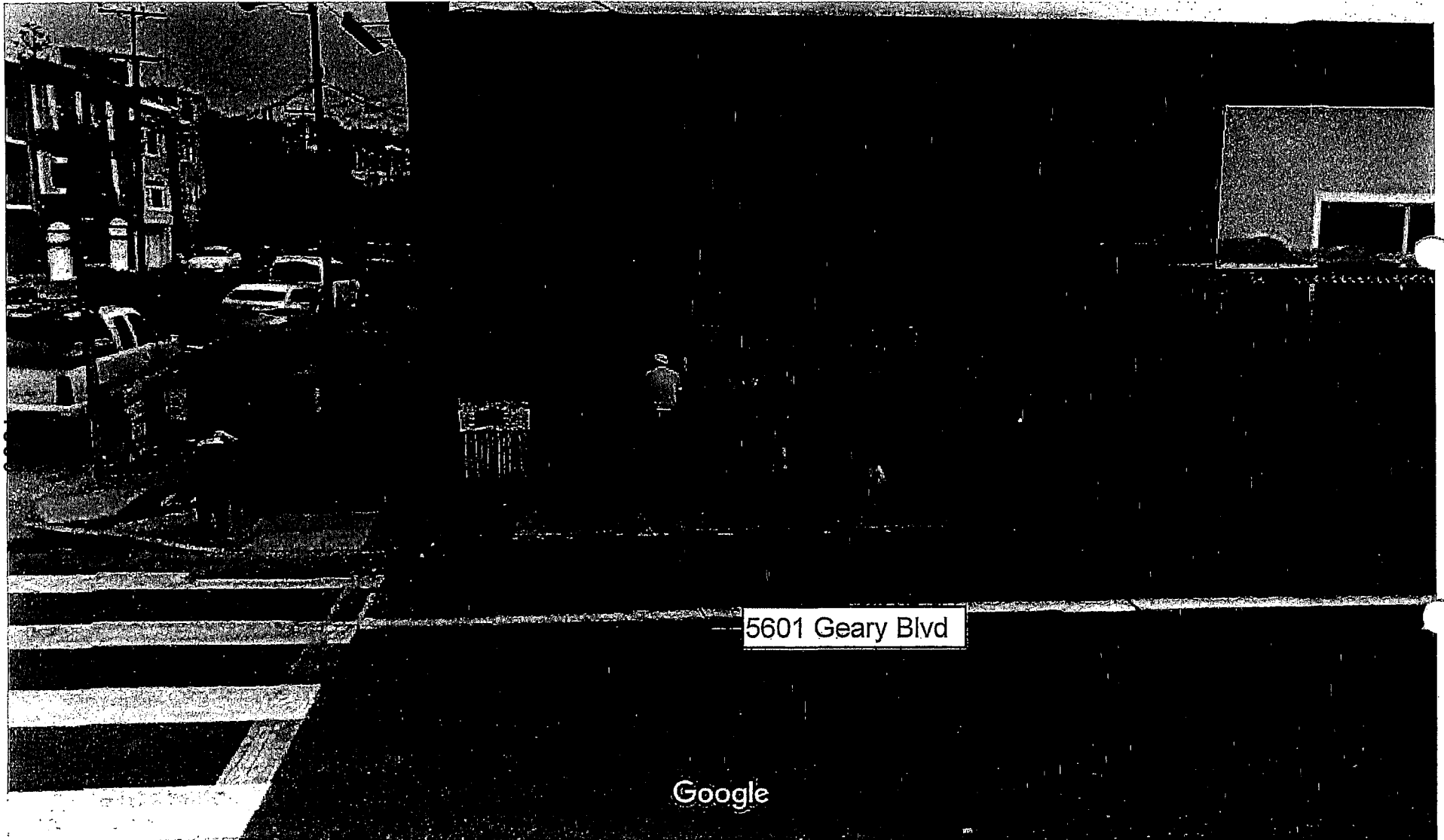
# Google Maps 5601 Geary Blvd

The purpose of this letter is to request to be placed on the Board's Calendar for Public Convenience and Necessity with regard to Mainland Market Co.'s application for a Type 20, off sale Beer and Wine license at 5601 Geary Blvd., San Francisco, CA 94121.

Mainland Market has undergone quite a facelift in the last year and a half, and, in light of serving our community more efficiently, we are applying for a type 20 Beer and Wine license.

When we took over Mainland it was an old Chinese market that sold mostly produce. We've put a few hundred thousand dollars of blood, sweat and improvement into the business and it has become quite a loved and appreciated market in the neighborhood, serving both the American and Asian Richmond communities, and giving the densely residential area what it needs in terms of organic produce and natural foods, as well as many Asian items and basics. We want to extend our offering to include craft beers, wines from local regions, and interesting sakes to satisfy our customers.

We feel a Type 20 is a necessity because people shop for their dinner at Mainland and would appreciate the store being a "one stop shop" where they can bring home a bottle of wine to enjoy with dinner, or get that craft beer to enjoy with lunch. Mainland is a grocery market, plain and simple, and people need to "get everything they need" for a meal, not just part of it.


We keep a tight ship.... clean and beautiful. We've worked with local police when they need our camera footage for some reason, and are always cooperative. We get some major compliments from local residents letting us know how happy they are with the changes we've produced and how nice it is to be able to come to a location that is as inviting as ours has become. They say we've done a lot for our neighborhood as well (check some of the Yelp reviews!).

We hope you will see things the same way and approve a PCN for us.

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


