SAN FRANCISCO DAS ARGUE FOR THE HIGHEST BAILS IN CASES

- **IN THE MAJORITY OF FELONY AND MISDEMEANOR CASES IN SAN FRANCISCO, THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY ARGUES THAT THE ACCUSED SHOULD REMAIN IN CUSTODY PENDING TRIAL.**

JUDGES IN SAN FRANCISCO CONTINUE TO SET HIGH BAILS REGARDLESS OF DEFENDANT'S ABILITY TO POST BAIL

- **IN DEPT 9, 332 BAIL MOTIONS WERE FILED. THE HIGHEST BAIL AMOUNT WAS \$12 MILLION AND THE LOWEST WAS \$15K. THE AVERAGE BAIL AMOUNT WAS \$168,403.**
- **IN DEPT 11, 339 BAIL MOTIONS WERE FILED. THE HIGHEST BAIL AMOUNT WAS \$5 MILLION AND THE LOWEST WAS \$5K. THE AVERAGE BAIL AMOUNT WAS \$123,256.**
- **IN DEPT 12, 313 BAIL MOTIONS WERE FILED. THE HIGHEST BAIL AMOUNT WAS \$5 MILLION AND THE LOWEST WAS \$1K. THE AVERAGE BAIL AMOUNT WAS \$108,962.**

RACIAL DISPARITIES IN CASE OUTCOMES

AFRICAN AMERICANS ARE HELD IN PRETRIAL CUSTODY LONGER THAN WHITES.

- **62% LONGER IN PRETRIAL
CUSTODY.**
- **ON AVERAGE BLACK DEFENDANTS SERVE 30 DAYS LONGER IN CUSTODY.**

PEOPLE OF COLOR RECEIVE MORE SERIOUS CHARGES AT THE INITIAL BOOKING STAGE

- **THE MORE SEVERE INITIAL BOOKINGS FOLLOW AFRICAN AMERICANS THROUGH THE PROCESS, RESULTING IN A HIGHER RATE OF FELONY CONVICTIONS AND LONGER SENTENCES ON AVERAGE.**
- **CRIMINAL HISTORY HAS A RIPPLE EFFECT THAT IMPACTS PLEA NEGOTIATIONS FOR SUBSEQUENT CHARGES.**

DEFENDANTS OF COLOR RECEIVE LONGER SENTENCES THAN WHITE DEFENDANTS.

- **SENTENCES RECEIVED BY BLACKS ARE ON AVERAGE 28% LONGER THAN THOSE RECEIVED BY WHITES.**
- **PROBATIONS SENTENCES RECEIVE BY LATINOS ARE 55% LONGER THAN THOSE RECEIVED BY WHITES.**
