My main qualification is my record of public service in the U.S. Department of Justice and, before that, the Virginia Attorney General's Office. When DOJ leadership promoted me to the role of Senior Counsel, they highlighted my steadfast commitment to working collaboratively with everyone affected by my cases, including not only victims and courts but also defense counsel and, where appropriate, defendants themselves. My collaborative approach led to successful resolutions of matters including multiple major cases against pharmaceutical companies for fraudulently promoting opioid drugs. My secondary qualifications are that I am a parent raising a child in the city (I live on Green Street in Russian Hill with my wife, who is a Bay Area native, and my daughter, who is almost four years old), and I understand both sides of criminal justice issues because I have assisted close friends and immediate family members in situations where they have been arrested and faced serious criminal charges. Additionally, early in my career as an attorney, I represented a New York prison inmate who was physically abused by guards, and won a jury trial and a significant monetary judgment for him. My career in law enforcement has not blinded me to such challenges and complexities but rather has reinforced my passion for ensuring a justice system everyone can trust.

Navigating life as a multiracial woman, balancing professional and family responsibilities, and working in the public and private sectors for over three decades connects me directly with the communities our police department serves. Throughout my career, I have championed equity, safety, and accountability at every level of government. I have worked alongside immigrant families, small business owners, and community organizations across neighborhoods and have prioritized listening to and elevating voices that have been historically underrepresented in the decision making process. The Police Commission should focus on oversight while ensuring transparency and accountability without tying the hands of law enforcement. My approach to public safety reflects the concerns I hear every day from residents all over San Francisco. We cannot keep our neighborhoods safe if we don't have enough officers to respond when our residents need help. I support a department that reflects our values and has the resources to do its job. We must continue to give officers modern tools to solve crimes and deter criminal activity, especially now that we face a staffing shortage that grows with every passing year. The first community that comes to mind is that of greater San Francisco. Like all San Franciscans, on occasion I have needed the assistance of law enforcement: sometimes I benefited from a swift and compassionate response; other times I have been harmed by late or no response, due either to the department's lack of resources or an officer's apathy. As a criminal defense attorney of almost 18 years, I have represented numerous clients arrested by the SFPD, sometimes wrongfully, and thus I have built a career around testing and challenging the credibility of police and am adept at flushing mistruths in testimony. But I also know many members of the police department: a few with whom I grew up, who I consider friends; and a handful with whom I have become friendly on a professional basis – working on opposite sides of multiple cases, but as professionals who understand each has a job to do, without whom our justice system would not function. Many clients and some with whom I grew up come from neighborhoods where antagonistic relationships between the police and the community are endemic – where police suspicion extends well beyond specific individuals of interest, and where community-wide distrust of police is rampant. Through my life experience, I have become intimately familiar with this diverse array of communities, such that I understand the proper balance between acknowledging the difficulty of being an effective and honorable police officer versus the need to hold police to the high standard we should expect of anybody who chooses to pursue a career in law enforcement and the power that comes with it.

My qualifications are informed by my uniquely San Franciscan background and experience. I am a 4th generation San Franciscan, of Irish and Jewish decent, born in the city just like both of my parents and all four of my grandparents. All my forefathers left their respective homes on opposite sides of Europe to escape oppression and poverty. An Irish great grandfather became a streetcar driver on Market Street; his family was evicted from their apartment in the aftermath of the 1906 earthquake to make room for, and collect higher rents from wealthier residents who had been displaced by the fire. A great great grandfather on my Jewish side was an immigrant carpenter struggling to raise a family of four on the Upper East Side of Manhattan, who heeded the call to builders across the continental United States to come to help rebuild our city, moving here in 1906, followed by his wife and children who arrived by train on April 18, 1907 – the first anniversary of the quake. The lessons of their experiences – persecution, poverty, immigration, and the values of good education, hard work, family and community – were never lost on their descendants, including myself. San Francisco has provided the community in which my family was allowed to thrive and succeed without ever betraying those lessons. My wife, also born and raised in San Francisco, is a first generation Mexican American who grew up in the Mission District; we met at Sacred Heart Cathedral Prep in 1992. For the first 9 years of our marriage, we rented an apartment downstairs from the apartment where she grew up, which her family still rented. Her neighbors became my neighbors, her family and friends became my family and friends. Despite both of us finding success in legal careers, we remain renters in the city in which we both grew up. Living in the Mission, I witnessed how police conduct their work there, informed by characteristics unique to the Mission District. The differences included the types of patrols required in the Mission, and the ways some department members responded to community members - sometimes for better, sometimes for worse.

Business and/or Professional Experience: 18 Years as a Criminal Defense Attorney

As stated, I am a criminal defense attorney, representing numerous clients with pending cases at 850 Bryant, having represented close to one hundred others over the last 8 years. I served as a public defender for 10 years, between two other counties, and I have been in private practice in San Francisco since April 2018. My first job upon college graduation was at the Board of Supervisors, from 2000-2001. Between working at City Hall, at 850 Bryant, and living in San Francisco for the vast majority of my life, I have had tremendous and insightful experience with the SFPD.

I understand law enforcement from the perspective of a criminal defense attorney, but I also know enough police officers and Sheriff's deputies on a personal level to understand that oversight requires the right combination of 1) understanding policy and 2) empathizing with the people to whom any such policies apply and/or affect - which policies require strict application and enforcement, and which should allow for flexibility and second chances.

I was active in local civics between my college graduation in 2000 and the beginning of law school in 2003. I have been eager to re-engage.



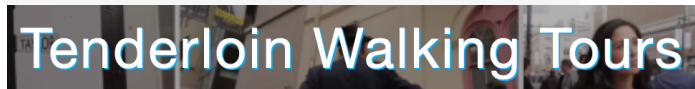
