The Office of the Mayor Behested Payment Waiver Report

October 31, 2025 – April 30, 2026

Legislative Requirement

On October 28, 2025, the Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No. 514-25 approving a waiver of the City's Behested Payments Ordinance (Campaign and Governmental Conduct Code, Sections 3.600 et seq.) for the Mayor, the Mayor's Chief of Staff, the Deputy Chief of Staff, the Director of Communications & Public Affairs, the Chief of Protocol, and the Policy Chiefs (Health, Homelessness & Family Services, Housing & Economic Development, Infrastructure, Climate & Mobility, and Public Safety), and each of their direct reports, for a period of six months beginning on October 31, 2025. Resolution No. 514-25 included a requirement for the Office of the Mayor to submit a report to the Board of Supervisors detailing donations solicited under this waiver within 60 days of the expiration date of the waiver (June 29, 2026).

The Office of the Mayor Behested Payment Reporting

The Office of the Mayor has established successful public-private partnerships to respond to the issues posed by homelessness and substance abuse, improving public safety and addressing mental health needs.

One behested payment was solicited from interested parties under this waiver for responding to the issues posed by homelessness and substance abuse, improving public safety and addressing mental health needs.
