1 [Temporary Sidewalk Closure - Dreamforce 2026 - Both Sides of Howard Street Between 3rd
2 Street and 4th Street]

3 **Resolution authorizing the temporary closure of the public sidewalk on both sides of**
4 **Howard Street between 3rd Street and 4th Street, from September 12 through**
5 **September 18, 2026, subject to Interdepartmental Staff Committee on Traffic and**
6 **Transportation issuing a permit for each year's event.**

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8 WHEREAS, Transportation Code, Article 6 provides for the temporary use and
9 occupancy of a public street for events receiving a permit from the Interdepartmental Staff
10 Committee on Traffic and Transportation (ISCOTT); and

11 WHEREAS, Transportation Code, Section 6.7 provides that the temporary use or
12 occupancy of a public street shall not unnecessarily obstruct or bar public access onto said
13 street, and that sidewalks shall remain open at all times for pedestrian use unless closure of
14 the sidewalk is provided for by Resolution of the Board of Supervisors explaining the reason
15 for such closure; and

16 WHEREAS, Dreamforce is an annual event sponsored by Salesforce, taking place in
17 San Francisco since 2003; and

18 WHEREAS, Dreamforce brings tens of thousands of visitors to San Francisco each
19 year as it takes place at the Moscone Center and surrounding streets over three days; and

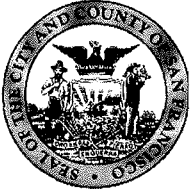
20 WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors determines that the closure of the sidewalks on
21 both sides of Howard Street between 3rd Street and 4th Street, from September 12, 2026,
22 through September 18, 2026, is necessary to facilitate the event; and

23 WHEREAS, Authorization for the temporary closure of the above sidewalks is subject
24 to ISCOTT issuing a permit for the event; and

1 WHEREAS, This Resolution is not a stand-alone authorization to close the subject
2 sidewalks; any such closures are subject to ISCOTT approving an event permit for this year's
3 Dreamforce event that authorizes closure of the subject sidewalks and is subject to the City's
4 discretionary adoption of California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Findings for the
5 project, following review and consideration of completed project related environmental
6 analysis, where required; now, therefore, be it

7 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the temporary closure of the
8 sidewalks on both sides of Howard Street between 3rd Street and 4th Street, from September
9 12 through September 18, 2026, subject to ISCOTT issuing a permit for the event.
