**Ordinance amending Sections 174.04 and 174.13 of the San Francisco Traffic Code,
pertaining to speed limits on Cesar Chavez Street.**

Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

Section 1. The San Francisco Traffic Code is hereby amended by amending Section 174.04, to reads as follows:

SEC. 174.04. A prima facie speed limit of 25 miles per hour is hereby established on ~~Army~~ Cesar Chavez Street between Kansas and Hampshire Streets.

Section 2. The San Francisco Traffic Code is hereby amended by amending Section 175.13, to reads as follows:

SEC. 175.13. A prima facie speed limit of 30 miles per hour is hereby established on ~~Army~~ Cesar Chavez Street, from Third Street to a point 500 feet east of Kansas Street.

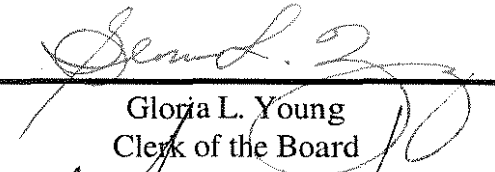

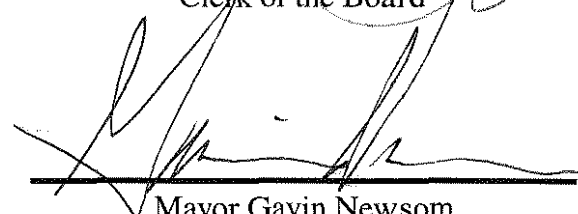
