

1 [Authorizing preparation of Proponent/Opponent ballot arguments and rebuttal ballot  
2 arguments for submittal to the voters at the November 3, 2009 Election.]  
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4 **Motion authorizing preparation of written Proponent and Opponent ballot arguments**  
5 **and rebuttal ballot arguments for submittal to the voters at the November 3, 2009**  
6 **Election.**

7 WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors wishes to authorize the Board Member  
8 sponsors of the following ballot measures to prepare and submit a written proponent ballot  
9 argument and proponent rebuttal argument for submittal to the Director of Elections:  
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- 11 • Charter Amendment to amend the Charter of the City and County of San Francisco by  
12 amending Section 2.117 to eliminate the reference to the number of staff members  
13 provided for members of the Board of Supervisors. (Supervisor McGoldrick)

- 15 • Charter Amendment amending Sections 3.105, 9.100, 9.101, 9.102, 9.103, 9.104,  
16 9.113, 9.113.5, 9.114, 11.100, A8.409-4, A8.590-5, A8.590-8, and Article XVII, and  
17 adding Sections 9.119 and 9.120 to institute a "rolling" two-year budgetary cycle (the  
18 City would adopt a new two-year budget each year), allow the Board of Supervisors to  
19 convert the rolling two-year budgetary cycle for some or all departments into a "fixed"  
20 two-year cycle (each two-year budget would stay in effect for two years), impose a  
21 deadline of May 10 or May 15 for submission to the Board of Supervisors of new terms  
22 and conditions of employment for miscellaneous or safety employees if those terms  
23 and conditions are to be effective during the upcoming fiscal year, allow the Board of  
24 Supervisors to determine, by ordinance, how City departments, including the Board of  
25 Supervisors, will comply with the Charter's publication requirements, and allow the

1 Controller to certify the availability of funds based on the expectation that funds will  
2 become available during the course of the budgetary cycle. (Mayor, Supervisors Chiu,  
3 Mirkarimi, Avalos, Campos)

5 • Motion ordering submitted to the voters an ordinance authorizing the amending San  
6 Francisco Administrative Code Section 4.24 to allow the Recreation and Park  
7 Department to enter into an agreement for the naming of City-owned sports stadium  
8 located at Candlestick Point, and to use fifty percent of the revenue from the  
9 agreement to fund recreation center directors at an election to be held on November 3,  
10 2009. (Supervisors Dufty, Elsbernd)

14 agreement to fund recreation center directors at an election to be held on November 3,

22 designated opponents of each measure, as listed above, under the provisions of the San  
23 Francisco Elections Code Sections 530 and 550, to prepare and submit a written proponent  
24 and opponent ballot argument and respective rebuttal ballot arguments on their measures;

1            FURTHER MOVED, That the sponsors and opponents of measures submitted to the  
2 voters for the November 3, 2009, Election, who are authorized by this motion to prepare and  
3 submit arguments, may authorize or assign to any other person(s) under the provisions of the  
4 San Francisco Elections Code Sections 530 and 550 (c) and (d) the right to prepare and  
5 submit the proponent or opponent's ballot arguments and/or respective rebuttal arguments.

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
