[Urging the S.F. Public Utilities Commission to Discontinue Plans for a Quarry in Sunol.]

Resolution urging the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission to discontinue plans for a quarry in Sunol that will result in safety and health impacts to students of Sunol Glen School and environmental desecration.

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Public Utilities Commission (SFPUC) owns significant acreage in the Alameda County town of Sunol; and

WHEREAS, SFPUC has moved forward in an agreement with Mission Valley Sand and Gravel to extend several existing quarry sites on the east side of Interstate 680; and,

WHEREAS, Existing quarry sites have resulted in dirt, dust, noise and unmitigated visual impact; and,

WHEREAS, The Mission Valley Rock quarry project will negatively impact the nearby Sunol Glen School, which is now located within 200 yards of the proposed excavation; and,

WHEREAS, The Mission Valley Rock quarry project will negatively impact the town of Sunol because the quarry will deter customers and tourists, reduce property values and cause inconvenience for Sunol residents; and,

WHEREAS, The Mission Valley Rook quarry will result in permanent loss of nearly 200 acres of prime farmland and permanently destroy nearly 200 acres of wildlife habitat; and,

WHEREAS, The project is not consistent with Alameda County's own East County Area Plan in at least four major respects; and,

WHEREAS, The Sunol Glen School Board adopted a resolution opposing this project on March 18, 1997; and,

WHEREAS, SFPUC member Dennis Normandy raised important issues in his dissent, most notably a viable proposal to use the land for wineries; now, therefore, be it

SUPERVISOR CHRIS DALY

RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors respectfully urges the SFPUC to discontinue its plans to develop a quarry on the site; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors requests the City Attorney to provide options for ending the contract with Mission Valley Rock Company; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors requests the Clerk of the Board forward this resolution to the SFPUC, Save Our Sunol, State Senator Liz Figueroa and the Alameda County Board of Supervisors.
