### Background

- Since 2004, City has held consolidated contract for refuse collection with services for City government facilities through the Office of Contract Administration
- Sole source contract approved in 2014 for 6 years, NTE \$48M
- November 2020: new contract was before the Board but no action taken
  - For continuity of refuse service, OCA entered into an interim contract covering Dec 2020 – Nov 2021
    - Original NTE: \$5.6M, amended to \$9.9M
    - Duration: December 1, 2020 June 30, 2021, amended to Nov. 30, 2021
  - Board approved contract extension in November 2021
    - NTE: \$15.6M
    - **Duration:** December 1, 2020 June 30, 2022
  - Board approved contract extension in June 2022 allows time to solicit for new services
    - **Current NTE**: \$39.6M
    - Current Duration: December 1, 2020 June 30, 2024
  - OCA amended June 2023 to adjust rates, as authorized by Board in June 2022

#### **Proposed Amendment 5**

- Amendment to current contract required to ensure continuity of service while City negotiates and executes new agreement
- Continues favorable contract terms
  - <u>Duration</u>: 4-month extension to October 31, 2024
  - NTE: \$43.8M based on current utilization
  - Scope: No change
  - Rates: No change

#### Solicitation for New Contract

- June 2022: City issues solicitation for new City refuse services contract. Two firms submit proposals:
  - Allied Waste Services of North America, LLC
  - Recology
- January 2023: Evaluation complete, issue Notice of Intent to Award to Allied Waste Services
- February 2023: CEQA process kicks off
- November 2023: Allied Waste Services submits application for truck permits
- February 2024: Planning completes CEQA process Addendum issued
- February 2024: OCA submits new contract to BOS for approval
- March 2024: Allied Waste Services withdraws proposal following BOS Budget & Finance Committee meeting
- March 2024: OCA negotiates extension with Recology for current contract (proposed Amendment 5)
- <u>June 30, 2024</u>: Current contract with Recology ends

#### **Next Steps**

- May 2024: Commence negotiations on new contract
- No later than August 2024: Conclude negotiations and finalize new contract
- August 2024: BOS submission
- October 2024: BOS approval and execution of new contracts
