3	Resolution urging Governor Gray Davis to sign Senate Bill 1736.

6	WHEREAS, California State Senate Bill 1736 (SB1736) was passed by the California
7	State Legislature and is awaiting a decision from Governor Gray Davis; and,
8	WHEREAS, SB 1736 would enable farmworkers who are unable to negotiate contracts
9	with growers to resolve impasses with management in binding arbitration; and,
10	WHEREAS, The United Farm Workers (UFW) launched a 150-mile march from Merced
11	to Sacramento and will hold a rally on August 25 <sup>th</sup> at the State Capitol to demonstrate their
12 13	support for this legislation; and,
14	WHEREAS, The UFW reports that 75% of farmworkers earn less that \$10,000 a year
15	and that 90% have no health coverage; and,
16	WHEREAS, The UFW posits that SB 1736 would "fill a hole" in the state's Agricultural
17	Labor Relations Act of 1975, which authorized union elections but left few remedies when
18	agreements are not reached; and,
19	WHEREAS, Out of the 428 elections that the UFW has won in the past 27 years, the
<ul><li>20</li><li>21</li></ul>	union has arrived at a contract with only 185 growers; now, therefore be it
22	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
23	urges Governor Gray Davis to sign SB 1736; and be it
24	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors transmit copies of
25	this resolution to the office of Governor Gray Davis.
