5 **lawsuit was filed on January 31, 2005, in San Francisco Superior Court, Case No.**  
6 **436930; entitled Jane Martin, et al. v. City and County of San Francisco, et al.**

7 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

8 Section 1. The City Attorney is hereby authorized to settle the portion of the action  
9 entitled "Jane Martin, et al. v. City and County of San Francisco, et al." San Francisco  
10 Superior Court, Court No. 436930, as it relates only to co-plaintiff Sunday Bazaar/2170 Folsom  
11 LLC, by the payment of \$60,000, representing the claim for diminution of property value, and  
12 excluding attorney's fees, costs and interest, which will be addressed in later proceedings.

13 Section 2. The above-named action was filed in San Francisco Superior Court on  
14 January 31, 2005, and the following settling parties were named in the lawsuit: Plaintiffs  
15 Sunday Bazaar and 2170 Folsom, LLC and Defendant City and County of San Francisco.
