7	WHEREAS, one in four children and one in five adults lives with daily threat of hunger;
8	and,
9	WHEREAS, there are nearly 150,000 San Franciscans that live with the threat of
10	hunger everyday; and,
11	WHEREAS, hunger is a citywide phenomenon that afflicts people without regard for
12	age, ethnicity, gender, family-size and employment status; and,
13	WHEREAS, the San Francisco Food Bank is a non-profit, whose mission is to end
14	hunger in San Francisco; and,
15	WHEREAS, the San Francisco Food Bank, St. Anthony Foundation and Project Open
16	Hand are dedicated to distributing food to everyone in need; and,
17	WHEREAS, the San Francisco Food Bank will distribute 23 million pounds of food to
18	hungry San Franciscans this year—enough to provide 50,000 meals every day of the year;
19	and,
20	WHEREAS, the San Francisco Food Bank and St. Anthony Foundation are committed
21	to advocating for improvements in government food programs and policies; and,
22	WHEREAS, the City and County of San Francisco share the commitment to end
23	hunger within the City; now, therefore, be it
24	RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco Board of Supervisors extends
25	their highest recommendation to the San Francisco Food Bank, St. Anthony Foundation and
