Resolution requesting San Francisco's representatives in the State Legislature to support amendments to the Vehicle Code to prohibit the use of hand-held cell-phones while driving a motor vehicle.

WHEREAS, AB 911 by Assemblymember Simitian is being considered by the California legislature and would prohibit the use of hand-held cell phones while driving a motor vehicle; and

WHEREAS, Anecdotal information suggests that the use of cell-phones while driving motor vehicles has dramatically increased in San Francisco and is positively correlated to pedestrian injuries from motor vehicle accidents; and,

WHEREAS, Numerous studies conducted in both the United States and in Europe have concluded that the use of hand-held cell phones while driving creates a significant driver distraction and contributes significantly to an increased likelihood of vehicle accidents, including those involving pedestrians; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges our representatives in the California legislature and Governor Davis to support AB 911 by Assemblymember Simitian.
