14 theatre piece to premier in San Francisco, in the year 2000, based
15 upon their journey; and,

16 WHEREAS, The artists have dedicated and committed their own time
17 and money into a cause they are much involved in with hopes of
18 gaining support from the communities in which the performances and
19 ceremonies will take place; now, therefore, be it

20 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County
21 of San Francisco commends The First Light for its valuable

23 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and
24 County of San Francisco declares August 6, 1999 to be "The First




