
8 WHEREAS, The Mayor of the City and County of San Francisco desires to undertake a

10 funded through the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, and,  
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
12 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco will utilize Domestic Preparedness

16 possible future terrorist incidents; now, therefore, be it  
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18 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Mayor's Criminal Justice  
19 Council of the City and County of San Francisco to retroactively apply, accept and expend a  
20 grant in the amount of One Hundred Thirty Five Thousand Nine Hundred Seventy Dollars  
21 (\$135,970.00) from the U.S. Department of Justice - Office of Justice Programs to administer the  
22 "State and Local Domestic Preparedness Equipment Support Program," for this fiscal year as  
23 well as future years based on federal appropriations, and does hereby waive indirect costs.


