1	[Urging SFUSD to waive fees for alternative programs to Summer School]
2	
3	Resolution urging the San Francisco Unified School District to provide free access to
4	school sites for alternatives to summer school programs. Furthermore, urging the
5	Mayor's Office in conjunction with the Board of Supervisors to secure funds for the
6	Unified School District to fill any shortfall that would result from waiving rental fees.
7	
8	WHEREAS, Due to expected cuts in California State funding for summer school
9	programs and given that the San Francisco Unified School District (SFUSD) has announced
10	that it is significantly cutting back its summer school program; and
11	WHEREAS, The paring down of, or canceling completely, some programs will leave
12	approximately 8,000 elementary school students and 4,000 middle and high-school students
13	without summer school and could have a devastating effect on students who will be left with
14	no alternative; and
15	WHEREAS, Summer school programs are important to good childhood development
16	because they provide educational and positive social activities; and,
17	WHEREAS, Working families and the poor cannot easily afford private after school and
18	summer activities for their children; and therefore, be it
19	RESOLVED, That The City should provide alternative programs to summer school for
20	students who will go without summer school as a result of state budget cuts; and therefore, be
21	it
22	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San
23	Francisco urge the Mayor's Office to recommend reallocating funds from under-performing
24	programs funded through the Children's Fund to alternative programs to summer school; and
25	therefore be it

1	FURTHER RESOLVED, That these alternatives to summer school programs would be
2	administered by the Department of Children Youth & Their Families to non profits that would
3	provide alternatives for youth; and, therefore, be it,
4	FURTHER RESIOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San
5	Francisco does hereby urge the San Francisco Unified School District to provide free access
6	to school sites for the alternative to summer school programs; and, therefore, be it,
7	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Mayor's Office in conjunction with the Board of
8	Supervisors, secure funds for the Unified School District to fill any shortfall that would result
9	from waiving rental fees.
