We write to express our support for the relocation of the store known as Cask on Third Street from the Hearst Building to the Monadnock Building, located in the building directly adjacent to ours.

From the start, the store has been a wonderful addition to the neighborhood. Their lease with us commenced in 2009 and during the 10 years since that opening, we have received zero complaints from the neighborhood or Hearst Building tenants about the store, its activity, or the well trained personnel who make it the delightful place it is. In addition to providing a colorful and intelligent selection of hard to find beverages, the staff takes an active interest in keeping the sidewalks clean and clear of any debris and papers from neighboring businesses such as Subway, for example. They draw an attractive group of customers to the store, which serves to activate and secure what can sometimes be a troubling neighborhood in the City.

Their relocation to the Monadnock Building will serve to revitalize the distinctly troubled area of North Annie Street by activating a long-vacant storefront (5 years I believe) and bringing life to an otherwise unsavory spot.

This is exactly the type of activity and small business entrepreneurship that we need to encourage in San Francisco. It would be a loss to our neighborhood if this business, Cask, was not able to relocate to the Monadnock Building, a change made necessary by the conversion of the Hearst Building to a boutique hotel.

To the Clerk of the Board,

The purpose of this letter is to respectfully request to be placed on the Board's calendar for Public Convenience and Necessity approval with regard to our Type 21 license transfer within District 6. We have enjoyed ten great years with Cask, our premium spirits, beer and wine store, in this wonderful neighborhood. However, change is upon us, and we are planning to move around the corner from our current home at the Hearst Building to the historic Monadnock Building at 685 Market Street. The reason for the relocation of the business is due to the pending conversion of the Hearst Building to a boutique hotel which was recently granted planning approval. The current Hearst Building location of Cask would become the lobby of the proposed new hotel.

We are excited with the possibility of keeping Cask in the neighborhood, pending approval of our ABC License Transfer. The proposed new location is the space formerly occupied by "Jeffrey's Toys", which has been shuttered for four years. Here, we would offer a new Cask store with its' fine range of beverage. Our colleagues employed at Cask would move with us to the new location, if approved. We are hoping that our neighbors, and our customers will also follow us around the corner. Cask has served as a convenient location for the purchase of fine beverage. Because the location we are proposing to relocate to was not formerly licensed by the ABC, we are required to seek your approval as the governing body.


