[Sunshine Ordinance Task Force Membership] AMENDING ARTICLE IV, CHAPTER 67, PART I OF THE SAN FRANCISCO MUNICIPAL CODE (ADMINISTRATIVE CODE), BY AMENDING SECTION 67.30 TO ADD TWO MEMBERS TO THE SUNSHINE ORDINANCE TASK FORCE, ONE MEMBER BEING A JOURNALIST FROM THE MINORITY PRESS OR ELECTRONIC MEDIA AND ONE MEMBER BEING AN ADDITIONAL MEMBER OF THE PUBLIC WHO HAS DEMONSTRATED INTEREST IN OR HAS EXPERIENCE IN THE ISSUES OF CITIZEN ACCESS AND PARTICIPATION IN LOCAL GOVERNMENT.

Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

Section 1. Article IV. Chapter 67 of the San Francisco Administrative Code is hereby amended by amending Section 67.30(a), to read as follows:

Section 67.30. THE SUNSHINE ORDINANCE TASK FORCE. (a) There is hereby established a task force to be known as the Sunshine Ordinance Task Force consisting of ((eleven)) thirteen voting members appointed by the Board of Supervisors. Two members shall be appointed from individuals whose names have been submitted by the local chapter of the Society of Professional Journalists, one of whom shall be an attorney and one of whom shall be a local journalist. One member shall be appointed from the press or electronic media who has an interest in the issues of citizen access and participation in local government. One member shall be appointed from individuals whose names have been submitted by the local chapter of the League of Women Voters. One member shall be a journalist from the minority press or electronic media. ((Five)) Six members shall be members of the public who have demonstrated interest in or have experience in the issues of citizen access and participation in local government. Two members shall be members of the public experienced in consumer

advocacy. At all times the Task Force shall include at least one member who shall be a member of the public who is disabled and who has demonstrated interest in citizen access and participation in local government. The Mayor and his or her designee, and the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors and his or her designee, shall serve as nonvoting members of the Task Force. The City Attorney shall serve as legal advisor to the Task Force.
