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Ordinance approving revised schedule of rates to be charged by the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission for water service to its retail customers inside and outside the City and County of San Francisco.

Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

Section 1. The Public Utilities Commission adopted on March 22, 2005, its Resolution No., after having held a public hearing on March 22, 2005, to consider a proposal for a 15% rate increase for fiscal year 2006 and a 15% rate increase for fiscal year 2007 for water service and water supplied to its retail customers inside and outside the City and County of San Francisco. Members of the public have been given an opportunity to express, and have expressed their views on the recommended Schedules of Rates. Pursuant to a published notice of intention of the Public Utilities Commission to adopt a revised Schedules of Rates to be charged for retail water service inside and outside the City and County of San Francisco and a public hearing held on March 22, 2005, a copy of said Schedules of Rates being on file in the office of the Secretary of the Commission, the Commission recommended a 15% rate increase for fiscal year 2006 and a 15% rate increase for fiscal year 2007 as enumerated in the Schedules of Rates to be charged for retail water service inside and outside the City and County of San Francisco.

Section 2. The foregoing rate schedules are for the purpose of meeting operating

obtaining funds for capital projects necessary to maintain service within existing service areas

expenses, including employee wage rate and fringe benefits, purchasing or leasing or

supplies, equipment or materials, meeting financial reserve needs and requirements,

1 and other budgetary requirements of the Public Utilities Commission's water service 2 enterprise. 3 Section 3. The Public Utilities Commission, in accordance with applicable laws, 4 recommended the revised Schedules of Rates to be charged for retail water service based 5 upon the water service enterprise budget for the current and ensuing fiscal years, and all the 6 data supporting such conclusions. The Public Utilities Commission has submitted data in 7 support of the Schedules to this Board for the current fiscal years 2006 and 2007. 8 Section 4. This Board of Supervisors hereby approves said Schedules for water 9 service and water supplied to its retail customers inside and outside the City and County of 10 San Francisco, which include a 15% rate increase for fiscal year 2006 and a 15% rate 11 increase for fiscal year 2007. 12 Section 5.
