9	Section 1. The San Francisco Administrative Code is hereby amended by addi	ng
0	Section 10.100-367, to read as follows:	
1	Sec. 10.100-367 PUBLIC EDUCATION SPECIAL FUND	
2	(a) Findings. The quality of public education in the City and County of San Francisco	<u>is an</u>
3	important factor in economic development and quality of life for San Francisco residents. The	Unified
4	School District relies heavily on state funds to provide for education. Significant reductions in	<u>state</u>
5	funding result in destabilization of our public education system. All aspects of City government	<u>it must</u>
6	act in concert to assure the education of our children.	
7	(b) Statement of Intent. The Board of Supervisors intends to address the above concern	<u>ıs by</u>
8	establishing a Public Education Special Fund to coordinate the City's financial investment in o	<u>our</u>
9	schools. This fund is intended to protect and preserve important programs in the Unified Scho	<u> 201</u>
20	District and improve the quality of public education in the City and County of San Francisco.	
21	(c) Establishment of Fund. The Public Education Special Fund is established as a cate	gory
22	four fund for the purposes of receiving all General Fund and Children's Fund revenues acc	ruing for
23	the purposes outlined herein, and any other funds intended for use by the San Francisco Unit	<u>fied</u>
24	School District and Board of Education established in Section 8.100 of the City Charter.	
25	(d) Use of Fund. The fund shall be used exclusively for the following purposes:	

1	(1) Arts and music programs in public schools;
2	(2) Health and wellness programs for Unified School District students;
3	(3) Middle and High School athletics;
4	(4) Early childhood development;
5	(5) Field trips for educational purposes;
6	(6) Reading recovery and or other supplemental academic support programs other
7	literacy programs;
8	(7) Providing student support services such as nurses and social workers:
9	(8) Providing instructional supplies for classroom teachers;
10	(9) Providing local funds to support the Unified School District's Secondary
11	Schools Redesign Initiative (SSRI) and leverage outside foundation support
12	for the SSRI;
13	(10) <u>Peer Resources:</u>
14	(11) <u>Posting of meeting information and materials on the Internet;</u>
15	(12) <u>State law requirements; and</u>
16	(13) Other uses determined by the Board of Education and approved by the Board of
17	Supervisors by motion.
18	(f) Reporting. The Board of Education shall file an semiannual report on the use of the
19	Fund with the Joint City and School District Committee or a successor committeeClerk of the
20	Board of Supervisors setting forth an accounting of the amounts disbursed and the uses for
21	which said funds were made.
22	(g) Budget Analyst Review. The Budget Analyst of the Board of Supervisors shall
23	conduct an annual review of the fund as part of the City budget process and report on whether
24	the expenditures of the fund fulfill the requirements outlined herein.

1	(h) (e) Public Education Special Fund Oversight Advisory Committee Established. A
2	Public Education Special Fund Oversight Advisory Committee is hereby established for the
3	purpose of providing a forum for the Mayor, Board of Supervisors, Board of Education and
4	education stakeholders to discuss issues related to the City's appropriation of funds to the
5	San Francisco Unified School District, on at least an annual basis.conducting a public hearing
6	as described in section (i). The Committee shall consist of the Mayor or his/her designee, the
7	Treasurer or her/his designee, the President of the School Board or his/her designee, the
8	Superintendent of Schools or his/her designee, the Chair of the Board of Supervisors
9	Committee that considers the budget or his/her designee, the Controller or his/her designee, a
10	parent representative appointed by the President of the School Board, a parent representative
11	appointed by the Superintendent, a representative of the Student Advisory Council of the San
12	Francisco Unified School District and a representative of the San Francisco Youth
13	Commission.
14	(i) Hearings. At least once a year, the Public Education Special Fund Oversight
15	Committee shall hold a public hearing to consider the reports and review contained in
16	subsections (f) and (g).
17	(i) Effective Date. This ordinance is effective on July 1, 2003.
