15 Arts Heritage Program, Melody of China, Pinay, Hanmadung Korean Youth
16 Cultural Center Drumming Group, the California Chinese Orchestra, Eva
17 Tam, Vinroc, the Asian American Jazz Orchestra, and Genny Lim; and,

18 WHEREAS, Through cultural and artistic performance, this event
19 celebrated the heritage and history of Asian Pacific Americans and
20 commemorated the many achievements of the community; and,

21 WHEREAS, These performances were sponsored through the
22 generosity of Bank of America; now, therefore, be it




