RE: Consideration of a Resolution recommending that the Board of Supervisors authorize the Department of Public Health to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the San Francisco General Hospital Foundation for Fundraising and Capital Projects

For your consideration is a Resolution recommending that the Board of Supervisors authorize the Department of Public Health to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding (“MOU”) with the San Francisco General Hospital Foundation for Fundraising and Capital Projects.

This MOU was developed in response to recommendations stemming from the San Francisco Controller’s ongoing public integrity review of contracts, purchase orders, and grants to the City and County of San Francisco (City) to identify process failures. Specifically, in September 2020 the Controller found:

“Clear and consistent contracts should be put in place for all city relationships with Friends of organizations, and both the sources and uses of these funds made publicly available.”

The MOUs presented for your consideration are approved to form by the City Attorney and Controller’s Office and directly address these public integrity findings.

The proposed MOU with the San Francisco General Hospital Foundation also includes a Capital Project addendum, The Zuckerberg San Francisco General Hospital (“ZSFG”) Building 5 Outpatient Health Center Capital Project” (“Project”), intended to fundraise \$200 million for the modernization of ZSFG Building 5.

The Project will convert outdated space in Building 5 to a state-of-the-art outpatient primary and specialty centers of excellence serving patients and families of all ages, ethnicities and populations in San Francisco
