WHEREAS, ~~MCJC~~ is the lead programmatic and fiscal agency in administering the Juvenile Accountability Incentive Block Grant, which provides funds for juvenile programs that ensure graduated sanctions and accountability measures; and

WHEREAS, the Juvenile Justice Coordinating Council of San Francisco has previously reviewed and approved the JAIBG program plan; and

WHEREAS, the funding available provides continuation funding for existing programs; and

WHEREAS, the positions authorized under the grant are designated as "G" or "Grant Funded" positions which would terminate when the grant expires; and

WHEREAS, indirect costs are hereby requested to be waived in order to maximize direct funding to programs; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the City and County of San Francisco hereby authorizes ~~MCJC~~ to retroactively accept and expend \$598,628 from the OCJP, State of California, to administer the Juvenile Accountability Incentive Block Grant Program.






