WHEREAS, January 30, 1998 is the 26th anniversary of "Bloody Sunday" when British paratroopers shot and killed fourteen participants in a civil rights march in Derry, Ireland and wounded thirteen more; and,

WHEREAS, The subsequent judicial tribunal carried out by Lord Chief Justice Widgery exonerated all the paratroopers involved and accused many of the victims of carrying guns and bombs at the time of their deaths; and

WHEREAS, For the past twenty-six years the friends and families of the victims have been campaigning to clear the names of those killed and bring to justice those responsible for their deaths; and

WHEREAS, The hidden Truths: Bloody Sunday Exhibition, which will open in San Francisco on January 30, 1999 is a continuation of that campaign for justice and civil rights. Having started in Mexico City in November, the exhibition will tour North America to educate its peoples as to the events of Bloody Sunday before returning to its permanent home in Derry's Civil Rights Museum; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco commends the Hidden Truths: Bloody Sunday Exhibition for its work on behalf of the Bloody Sunday victims and the civil rights movement.
