2 COMMENDING THE HIDDEN TRUTHS BLOODY SUNDAY EXHIBITION AND THE
3 FAMILIES OF THE BLOODY SUNDAY VICTIMS FOR THEIR WORK TO COMMEMORATE
4 BLOODY SUNDAY

5 WHEREAS, January 30, 1998 is the 26th anniversary of "Bloody
6 Sunday" when British paratroopers shot and killed fourteen
7 participants in a civil rights march in Derry, Ireland and wounded
8 thirteen more; and,

9 WHEREAS, The subsequent judicial tribunal carried out by Lord
10 Chief Justice Widgery exonerated all the paratroopers involved and
11 accused many of the victims of carrying guns and bombs at the time of
12 their deaths; and

13 WHEREAS, For the past twenty-six years the friends and families
14 of the victims have been campaigning to clear the names of those
15 killed and bring to justice those responsible for their deaths; and

16 WHEREAS, The hidden Truths: Bloody Sunday Exhibition, which will
17 open in San Francisco on January 30, 1999 is a continuation of that
18 campaign for justice and civil rights. Having started in Mexico City
19 in November, the exhibition will tour North America to educate its
20 peoples as to the events of Bloody Sunday before returning to its
21 permanent home in Derry's Civil Rights Museum; now, therefore, be it

22 RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco
23 commends the Hidden Truths: Bloody Sunday Exhibition for its work on
24 behalf of the Bloody Sunday victims and the civil rights movement.




