

1 [Accept and Expend Grant - PSI/Myanmar Collaborative Impact Study Planning - \$25,578]

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3 **Resolution authorizing the Department of Public Health to retroactively accept and**
4 **expend a grant from the Regents of the University of California in the amount of**
5 **\$25,578 to participate in a program entitled “PSI/Myanmar Collaborative Impact Study**
6 **Planning” for the period of July 1, 2010, through June 30, 2011.**

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8 WHEREAS, UCSF is the recipient of a grant award from Population Services
9 International/Myanmar supporting the PSI/Myanmar Collaborative Impact Study Planning;
10 and,

11 WHEREAS, With a portion of these funds, UCSF has subcontracted with DPH in the
12 amount of \$25,578 for the period of July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011; and,

13 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, UCSF requires the City to
14 enter into an agreement (the “Agreement”), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the
15 Board of Supervisors in File No. _____; which is hereby declared to be a part of
16 this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

17 WHEREAS, An ASO amendment is not required as the grant partially reimburses DPH
18 for one existing position, one Senior Physician Specialist (Job Class 2232) at .10 FTE, for the
19 period of July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011; and,

20 WHEREAS, A request for retroactive approval is being sought because DPH did not
21 receive notification of the contract until February 1, 2011 for a project start date of July 1,
22 2010; and,

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1 WHEREAS, The budget includes a provision for indirect costs in the amount of \$2,325;
2 now, therefore, be it

3 RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend a grant retroactively
4 in the amount of \$25,578 from UCSF; and, be it

5 FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and
6 expend the grant funds pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section 10.170-1; and,
7 be it

8 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the
9 agreement on behalf of the City.
