FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco hereby authorizes the Department of Children, Youth and Their Families to apply for, accept, and expend funds in the amount of \$528,000 from the United States

Department of Agriculture (USDA) to sponsor the Mayor's Summer Food Service Program.
