

1 [Appointments, Sunshine Ordinance Task Force - Matthew Cate and Lila LaHood]

3 **Motion appointing Matthew Cate (residency requirement waived) and Lila LaHood,**
4 **terms ending April 27, 2020, to the Sunshine Ordinance Task Force.**

6 MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco does
7 hereby appoint the hereinafter designated persons to serve as members of the Sunshine
8 Ordinance Task Force, pursuant to the provisions of Administrative Code, Section 67.30, for
9 the terms specified:

10 Matthew Cate (residency requirement waived) seat 1, succeeding Victoria Baranetsky,
11 resigned, must be nominated by the local chapter of the Society of Professional Journalists
12 and be an attorney, for the unexpired portion of a two-year term ending April 27, 2020.

13 Lila LaHood, seat 2, succeeding Eric Eldon, resigned, must be nominated by the local
14 chapter of the Society of Professional Journalists and be a journalist, for the unexpired portion
15 of a two-year term ending April 27, 2020.

16 FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors makes the following findings:

- 17 1. The membership of the Sunshine Ordinance Task Force has a goal to be
18 representative of the diversity of the City and County of San Francisco.
- 19 2. Applicant Matthew Cates, who is not a resident of San Francisco, is a person
20 with experience that uniquely qualifies them to serve on the Sunshine Ordinance
21 Task Force.
- 22 3. The Sunshine Ordinance Task Force has attempted to fill the positions, for
23 which Matthew Cate was nominated, with individuals who are City residents and
24 who have the specific experience, skills, and qualifications, but has been unable

to do so at this time. The Rules Committee has certified that Matthew Cate is qualified to serve on the Sunshine Ordinance Task Force.

- 4. After exercising due diligence, the Board of Supervisors concludes that there is no other possible representative, who is a resident of San Francisco, and who has the specific experience, skills, or qualifications possessed by this applicant, and who is willing to serve on the Sunshine Ordinance Task Force at this time; and, be it

FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives the residency requirement for Matthew Cate, as allowed in cases where no qualified City resident, willing to serve, can be found, pursuant to Charter, Section 4.101(a)(2), that requires person(s) appointed to boards, commissions, and advisory bodies established by legislative act of the Board of Supervisors to be resident(s) of the City and County of San Francisco.


