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3 **Ordinance amending the FY2010-2011 Annual Salary Ordinance**

4 **(File No. ) to reflect the addition of temporary salaries of \$22,698,000 and**  
5 **authorizing the Human Services Agency to retroactively accept and expend a grant not**  
6 **to exceed the amount of \$52,038,115 from the United States Department of Health and**  
7 **Human Services, as part of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, to**  
8 **support the Mayor's Jobs NOW Program, and authorizing the Human Services Agency**  
9 **to accept and expend an additional grant not to exceed \$101,793,566 pending final**  
10 **approval by the U.S. Congress to extend federal funding beyond September 30, 2010,**  
11 **for a total amount not to exceed \$153,741,681.**

17 Section 1. **Grant-funded Positions; Amendment to FY 2010-2011 Annual Salary**  
18 **Ordinance.**

20 2011 is hereby amended so that the same shall read as follows:

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4           **Section 2. Authorization to Accept and Expend Funds.**

5           The United States Department of Health and Human Services provides funds to the  
6 City and County of San Francisco, through the California Department of Social Services, to  
7 operate the California Work Opportunity and Responsibility to Kids (CalWORKs) Program.  
8 CalWORKs funds include local and state dollars as well as federal Temporary Aid to Needy  
9 Families (TANF) dollars. With the passage of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act  
10 of 2009 (ARRA), Congress created the TANF Emergency Contingency Fund (ECF) and  
11 expanded the kinds of expenses that can be reimbursed with TANF funds. The Human  
12 Services Agency is now able to claim reimbursement for expenses associated with subsidized  
13 employment programs and related ancillary services for current and former recipients of  
14 CalWORKs aid and for families earning income less than 200% of the Federal Poverty Level.  
15 TANF is an eligibility-based public assistance program and employers providing work to  
16 eligible individuals under the Jobs NOW Program are program participants, and not  
17 contractors or grantees subject to traditional contracting requirements imposed by the City  
18 and County of San Francisco.

19           In Fiscal Year 2009-2010, the Board of Supervisors authorized the Human Services  
20 Agency to accept and expend grant funds for the Jobs NOW Program. Currently the provision  
21 of federal TANF ECF funds for Jobs NOW is scheduled to sunset September 30, 2010.  
22 However, the TANF ECF program is expected to receive additional Congressional authority  
23 through September 2011. This Ordinance would extend the authority of the Human Services  
24 Agency to accept and expend \$153,741,681 in Fiscal Year 2010-11, including \$52,038,115

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1 until September 30, 2010 and an additional \$101,793,566 through June 30, 2011, upon  
2 confirmation of the federal extension of the TANF ECF. The Department proposes to  
3 maximize use of available grant funds on program expenditures by not including indirect costs  
4 in the grant budget.
